



- › **Camus:** Prince de Bretagne's historical variety and France's most widely grown artichoke.
- › **Castel:** Lighter in colour and more pointed. Appreciated for their storage qualities.

Cardinal



Cardinal are fleshy artichokes exclusive to Prince de Bretagne.

- › Notable for their purple colour, tightly packed heads and thornless leaves.
- › **Their excellent on-shelf conservation is a real bonus.**
- › Subtle and sweet, Cardinals have been tested with consumers who readily identify them.

Petit Violet



Petit Violet artichokes are notable for their colour, small size and the absence of chokes.

- › Prince de Bretagne offers them by the head in 4 different sizes or in 'poivrade' bunches of 5 heads.



REMEMBER

On Prince de Bretagne artichoke plants, we generally harvest only 3 heads, selecting the mother head and 2 subsidiaries in order to offer dense, fleshy artichokes.



CONSERVATION: In humid cold storage and away from light.



ON SHELF: These are vegetables that are prone to drying out, hence the importance of stock rotation. Offer 2 or 3 varieties according to the space you have available.

VARIETAL CREATION: LIMITING TREATMENTS

Plant breeders OBS (Organisation Bretonne de Sélection) and Prince de Bretagne are developing new disease-resistant Traditional shallot varieties. These are reserved exclusively for our market gardeners and are adapted to their growing conditions. Thanks to these varieties, our market gardeners apply fewer treatments to their Traditional shallot crops.

Traditional shallots



Two types of shallots are offered by our market gardeners: long (the majority of sales) and semi-long.

- › A highly **diverse packaging range** is available, from 250g nets to 5kg sacks and 500g plait.
- › Thanks to customised storage conditions ideal for shallots, **produce retains all its qualities throughout the year**.

Pink garlic



Brittany pink garlic is renowned for its flavour, delicate aroma and good keeping qualities.

- › It is grown and cleaned entirely **by hand** to protect its qualities.
- › Available from September to March in **various packing formats**: loose, three-head sachets, plait and punnets of cloves.

Shallots grown without pesticides from leaf stage to plate



- › Created exclusively by and for Prince de Bretagne's market gardeners, **new disease-resistant varieties** make it possible to grow Traditional shallots without synthetic pesticide treatments from leaf stage to plate.
- › **This production is monitored and validated by an independent certification body.**



Recognition

- › Prince de Bretagne grows and sells only Traditional shallots, guaranteeing consumers are buying genuine shallots.



ONIONS AND ECHALIONS

KEY FIGURES

DEFENDING OUR REGION

In accordance with the specifications, Roscoff PDO onions are **grown, cleaned and packed** in the PDO's geographical area (27 municipalities around Roscoff).

Roscoff onions PDO



- › Roscoff onions were awarded an **AOC (Appellation d'Origine Contrôlée)** in 2009 and in 2013 earned official European recognition via a PDO (Protected Designation of Origin).
- › The PDO guarantees the **origin of the product**, its natural conservation methods and manual cleaning conducted by Prince de Bretagne's market gardeners.

Brittany pink onions



- › Brittany pink onions are grown outside the geographical area identified in the PDO.
- › Pink onions are packed mechanically, mainly in **1kg net bags and 5kg sacks**.

Echalions



- › Elongated onions sometimes known as banana shallots.
- › Considered the fourth condiment.
- › Their flavour lies between that of shallots and onions.
- › Particularly appreciated in the **catering sector and for exports**.



FOCUS ON PLASTIC-FREE

500g and 1kg net bags of onions are available in cellulose netting with a paper label.
1kg plait of PDO Roscoff onions also benefit from plastic-free packaging.

A BOOST FOR THE LOCAL ECONOMY

Coco de Paimpol and Brittany haricots are harvested **by hand**. From August to October, hundreds of seasonal workers of all ages, known as 'plumeurs', are responsible for harvesting, providing a big boost to the **local economy**.

Coco de Paimpol PDO

- Harvested **entirely by hand**, Coco de Paimpol are sold as fresh pods.
- They are cooled before packing for **optimal conservation** and offered in 8kg and 5kg sacks, 1kg net bags and loose in 6kg boxes.
- 1kg net bags are perfect for encouraging consumers to try Coco de Paimpol and **reduce on-shelf losses** compared to loose sales.

Brittany haricot beans

- Prince de Bretagne also offers non-PDO beans: fresh Brittany haricot beans for podding, available in 8kg sacks.
